



Code of Conduct

YSFA is a service organization that works in cooperation with the Burlington Township School District and B. Bernice Young School Administration. As such, it is critical that YSFA volunteers conduct themselves in an appropriate manner during YSFA events.

The following code of conduct should be adhered to by YSFA volunteers during events:

1. Never be alone with a child, other than his or her own.
2. Treat others with respect and courtesy.
3. Adhere to all school and District rules and Policies.
4. Respect YSFA and School property, and only use it for its designated purpose.

Inappropriate or unsafe behavior, disputes, or any violation of school rules and/or School Board Policy should be reported to a YSFA Board Member or a District Administrator. Volunteers who violate the Code of Conduct may be asked to not participate in YSFA events as a volunteer until such violation has been properly resolved.
